# Specific TitleII Program Accomplishments:

- ✓ Since October 2024, 326 youth and 88 adults have participated in program activities funded through Title II
- ✓ A total of 59 diversion sessions have been provided at Blue Ridge Junior High, ShowLow School District and the Holbrook NCIS/HUB (Juvenile detention closed, so this Navajo County Instruction for success alt school is in place-HUB Hope Unity Belief)
- ✓ 2,285 media messages have been provided under the auspices of Title II funding. Media activities include: Digital signage, Facebook, Podcasts, and Radio PSAs. This range of media activities allows Nexus to message to most of Navajo County residents
- ✓ 6 resiliency presentations were provided with youth and 4 presentations with adults
- ✓ 2 cycles of Keep A Clear Mind have been provided
- ✓ 8 cycles of Lions Quest have been provided using all three aged focus curriculum (K-5, 6-8, 9-12)

- ✓ Nexus is collaborating with the White Mountain Business Roundtable that includes business owners and government representatives. These relationships are critical for supporting community activities with access to location and receiving donations of items such as snacks and water that are not otherwise paid for through grant funds. Another example, through collaboration with businesses, SNAP Fitness donated equipment to the HUB to increase youth opportunity for alternative activities (exercise)
- ✓ Nexus is an active member of SACLAZ which provides staff with access to a variety of substance focused presentations outlines and PowerPoints that can be used for educational presentations
- ✓ Nexus is fortunate to be the recipient of grant funding from a variety of organizations. This allows Nexus to weave the funding to provide a continuum of services and leverage the activities specifically provided under the auspices of Title II
- ✓ Nexus continually keeps it toolbox full of new approaches. Examples include:
  - ✓ Addition of Keep A Clear Mind to interact with younger youth
  - ✓ Transition of presentations from trauma focused to resiliency focused
  - ✓ Addition of 5 Skills of Resiliency BTAPS (Belief, Trust, Adaptability, Perseverance, Strength)—a single or multi session approach related to resiliency





# Safety Village – over 2400 kiddos



Established close working relationships with organizations that serve youth who may be a risk, are experiencing emotional disabilities, or have demonstrated behaviors that may result in them becoming involved in the juvenile justice system. Examples include:

- ✓ Nexus staff provided Lions Quest with youth in the Rise Program through the Show Low School District. The program serves youth who are experiencing an emotional disability at all grade levels
- ✓ Nexus staff have expanded the collaboration with HUB Center for Success In Holbrook. The HUB is an alternative school focused specifically with serving youth who are experiencing a variety of different kind of risks
- ✓ Nexus has established a diversion program that is designed to serve youth to meet individual needs
- ✓ Nexus staff continues to work Blue Ridge Junior High through the delivery of individualized diversion activities and Lions Quest
- ✓ Nexus has established a collaboration with Explore AZ School, a private school in Pinetop AZ initiating services through the delivery of Keep A Clear Mind
- ✓ Nexus participates in Teen Court to facilitate youth being referred to Diversion. It is unique because a Navajo County Justice of Peace also participates

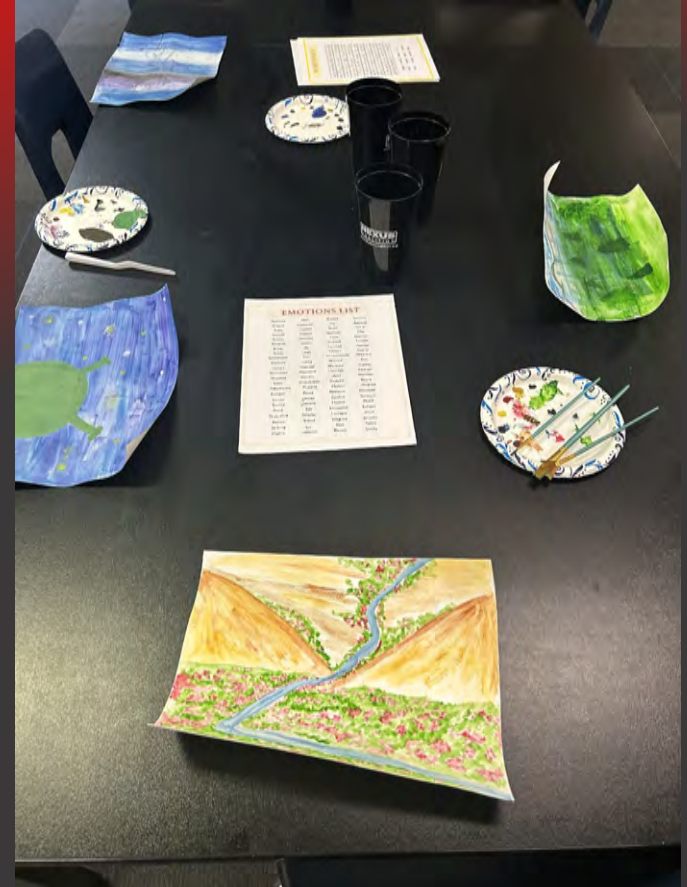

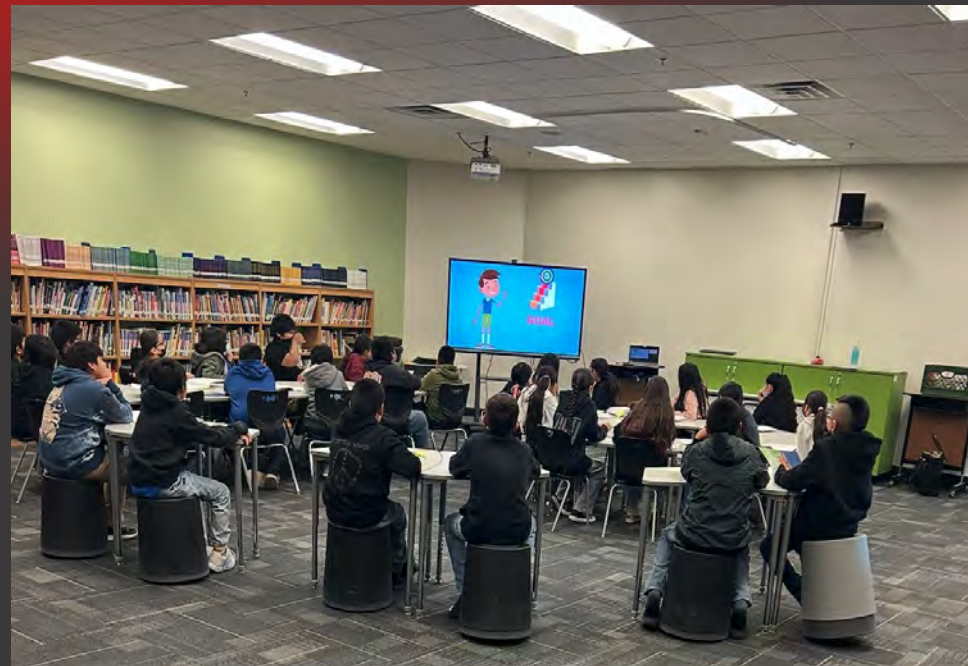
